PRIVACY AND PERSONAL DATA

The guidelines below detail the data protection policy of Set Sail Ministries regarding personal data. WeBelievedBook.com is a subsidiary of Set Sail Ministries.

If you communicate with us by phone, email, post messages to any of our social media groups, forums, or otherwise complete online forms, surveys or contest entries, any information provided in such communication may be collected as Personal Information.

By providing your personal information and data, you consent to the use, analysis and, where applicable, disclosure of such information by us according to the terms and conditions described herewith.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 What type of information we collect

We receive, collect and store any information you enter on our website or provide us in any other way. In addition, we collect the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet; login; e-mail address; password; computer and connection information and purchase history. We may use software tools to measure and collect session information, including page response times, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information, and methods used to browse away from the page. We also collect personally identifiable information (including name, email, password, communications); payment details (including credit card information), comments, feedback, product reviews, recommendations, and personal profile.

1.2 How we collect information

When you conduct a transaction on our website, as part of the process, we collect personal information you give us such as your name, address and email address. Your personal information will be used for the specific reasons stated above only.

1.3 Why we collect such personal information

We collect such Non-personal and Personal Information for the following purposes:

1. To provide and operate the Services;
2. To provide our Users with ongoing customer assistance and technical support;
3. To be able to contact our Visitors and Users with general or personalized service-related notices and promotional messages;
4. To create aggregated statistical data and other aggregated and/or inferred Non-personal Information, which we or our business partners may use to provide and improve our respective services;
5. To comply with any applicable laws and regulations.

1.4 Contact with you

We may contact you to notify you regarding your account, to troubleshoot problems with your account, to resolve a dispute, to collect fees or monies owed, to poll your opinions through surveys or questionnaires, to send updates about our company, or as otherwise necessary to contact you to enforce our User Agreement, applicable national laws, and any agreement we may have with you. For these purposes we may contact you via email, telephone, text messages, and postal mail.

2. MANAGEMENT OF PERSONAL DATA BY WEBELIEVEDBOOK.COM

Our company is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall.

All direct payment gateways offered by Wix.com and used by our company adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of credit card information by our store and its service providers.

2.1 Retention of data

We retain data collected for the purposes of managing premium subscriptions and active user accounts for a minimum of the term of service. Otherwise, data may be retained indefinitely unless you request that we delete it. Once we receive a data deletion request, we will undertake to delete all data within one week of the request.

2.2 Data recipients

Set Sail Ministries is the recipient of the data. We have security and privacy measures in place to ensure an adequate level of data protection. We do not in the normal course of business share your data with third parties unless they are a parent or an affiliate such as WeBelievedBook.com. We will only send your personal data to a third party if:

- you have given us your prior approval to share such information,
- we must share such information with third parties to provide a service you have requested, or
- we are required by a judicial authority or any other administrative authority to provide such information.

2.3 Data security and privacy

Set Sail Ministries has made every effort to put in place suitable precautions to safeguard the security and privacy of personal data, and to prevent it from being altered, corrupted, destroyed or accessed by unauthorized third parties.

However, the company does not control every risk related to the use of the Internet, and therefore warns visitors of the potential risks involved in the functioning and use of the Internet.

3. RIGHT TO ACCESS, CORRECT AND DELETE DATA AND TO OBJECT TO DATA PROCESSING

4. COOKIES

When you visit our company website, a cookie may be automatically installed and temporarily saved in your computer's memory or on its hard disk to make it easier for you to navigate around our site and to save your password. 5. HOW WE RESPOND TO DO NOT TRACK SIGNALS (DNT)

This site does not respond to DNT signals. If we are providing services to you, such as subscriptions or user accounts, we will track page views and sign-in logs for purposes of providing and improving our services. Clients or account holders who opt in to our services agree to this per this policy.

Some third-party sites accessed through our site will also track your browsing activities when they serve you content. If you are visiting such sites, your browser may allow you to set the DNT signal on your browser so that third parties (particularly advertisers) know you do not want to be tracked.
